



Regular Season Meeting of February 3, 2010

Greg Bing, President called the meeting to order at 6:30pm. There were 62 persons in attendance.

**Old Business:** Margaret Busbee from the Revenue and Compensation Committee proposed to increase the Commissioner's salary to \$7,000; the Vice-President / Assistant Commissioner's salary to \$1,200 and the Treasurer's salary to \$550 plus \$0.50 per check written, subject to annual review. This is based upon the increase of schools served and the increase in SABO Membership levels. The report of the Committee was approved by the membership.

Analee McPhilomy reported that the end of season banquet will be held after the February 17<sup>th</sup> meeting at Arden's Restaurant near Lee High School off Roosevelt Blvd, located at the corner of St. Johns and Hamilton (behind the old St. Johns Theatre). She reported that she will secure the auditorium at Lee High School as the February 17<sup>th</sup> meeting location

SABO will be awarding the JC Green Sportsmanship award to the school which exhibits the best sporting behavior during the 2009/10 season. **New Business:** Steve Woodsmall proposed the following constitutional Amendments:

Article VI, E.2.

To assign all varsity and junior varsity games booked by SABO, at the senior and junior high/middle school levels, boys and girls; and also to supervise the Assistant Commissioner and coordinate the assigning of games in an orderly manner. The commissioner shall be solely dedicated to the assignment process and shall not officiate games during the season.

Article XI, B.

Compensation for the commissioner will be paid from the SABO treasury and will be an annual fee of \$XXXX for the season. In consideration of this annual compensation, and as stated in Article VI above, the commissioner shall be solely dedicated to the assignment process and shall not officiate games during the season.

**Commissioner's Report:**

The schools will pay SABO for all District and Regional Tournament games.

For those of you working Girls District Tournaments this coming week, and for those who will work Boys Dist. Tournaments the following week: Remember that there is a different protocol for pregame warm-ups. The teams get only 15 minutes. The clock should be started 22 minutes before game time (example: 5:38PM for a 6PM starting time) . The clock runs out 7 minutes before game time- those 7 minutes are for reading of the FHSAA statements, National Anthem, player intros, etc.
